Bus transportation will be provided. Children <u>must</u> have reached three years of age by the first school day in September, 2018, to ride the school bus. Parents will be responsible to provide their child's transportation until his/her 3rd birthday.

A UPK <u>random draw</u> is required. - ✓ Thursday, April 26th Random Draw at 10:00 AM in the Large Instruction Room in the High School Building: Random draw is required to select the 2018-2019 full day UPK students. Applicants are welcome to attend, but not required. Parents may park in visitor parking in the south lot and enter the front doors of the High School. Identification must be shown when entering the building for the draw. Parents of the children selected in the draw will be notified promptly. Children who are selected in the draw must complete the district's registration process. Those who were not selected will be put on a waiting list.
